2023 PSMGA MATCH PLAY TOURNAMENT RULES

- Match Play Tournament begins on Monday April 10, 2023. You will sign up as an individual and Pecan Hollow will pair up opponents according to 100% of handicaps. The pairings will be made on the day of the tournament.
- 2. After the initial round of qualifying, winners will be divided into four flights. Winners who qualify in Match Play will automatically be scheduled, for the following week (you DO NOT need to sign up on the website).
- 3. Those players, who did not qualify for Match Play, and/or received a BYE, must sign up, as usual, on the website for the following week tournament.
- Match Play competitors CAN NOT play in the normal Stroke Play tournaments; however the Match Play competitors can play in the Closest-To-Pin and Hole-In-One contests.
- 5. It is required that the next scheduled Match be completed within one week. Match Play Competitors may agree to play at an earlier date, but must inform the Committee and the Pro Shop.
- 6. Any exceptions should be presented to the PSMGA Committee for approval/rulings.
- If not completed by the following Monday, the PSMGA Committee will have final determination on who continues based on whatever facts are available.

NOTE: Match Play is a hole-by-hole contest between two players, so each hole is either won/halved/or conceded. Refer to USGA Rule 3.2 for complete Match Play rules. The USGA and local PSMGA rules apply.
