

Annual PSMGA Reports - 2020

1. Treasurer's Report

The By-Laws require that I provide a Treasurer's financial report to the members at our annual meeting. However, due to COVID we are not having our annual meeting. But as a substitute, I am presenting this financial report.

As of the end of September:

1. General fund (Cash Reserves) is \$7009.15
2. Tournament winnings (retained member winnings) is 3629.88
3. Silver Tee Hole-In-One Fund is \$7,797.
4. Gold Tee Hole-In-One Fund is \$1,904.
5. Checkbook balance is \$20,340.03

If anyone would like to see a complete financial report, please e-mail me and I will forward it to you.

The 2021 dues for current members will be \$5. Those members who have at least \$5 in their account will have their Dues deducted on Dec 1, 2020. If you wish not to continue your membership please notify me by Nov 30, 2020 and your balance will be mailed to you. [\(please include your current mailing address\)](#)

For current members who do not have \$5 or more in their account your \$5 dues should be paid before first tournament round in 2021. The new member dues for 2021 will remain at \$20.

2. VP Tournaments & Rules Report and the Pecan Hollow Report are combined.

Old business:

1. There has not been any new PSMGA Rules implemented. Please review the PSMGA Local rules on the website.

New business:

TOURNAMENT PLAY IS ESTIMATED TO BEGIN JANUARY 4, 2021

1. Thursday's "GOLD TEE" Tournament has been canceled indefinitely.
2. TOURNAMENT PLAY: The schedule for 2021 tournaments will still depend on the status of COVID-19. With that said, and once we get back to playing, Thursday's (Gold Tee) tournament will no longer exist. Therefore, Monday will be the only day of tournament play. The Monday tournament will be played from a pre-designated set of tees (estimated at 5500-5800 yards).
3. There will not be two different tee boxes. Handicaps for play will be determined as necessary and will be adjusted accordingly.
4. Two players per cart will be utilized. Players will be allowed to "pick" your cart partner for the tournament. This will be done at the time of sign up. Maximum number of tournament players will be 130. Sign up procedures will stay the same.
5. Due to lack of tournaments played in 2020, the Committee has decided to reduce the 2021 dues to \$5.00 for current members. (Purpose of By-Law Amendment). The dues for new members will continue to be \$20 as per the PSMGA By-Laws.
6. Purchase of new punch cards will be available 1 December 2020. The cost will be \$300 for 10 rounds of golf. This is still a discount of \$5 per round of golf. Normal Senior rate (without a punch card) is \$35. These new punch cards can only be used on Monday thru Thursday (excluding holidays).
7. The Pro Shop is recommending using the punch card in purchasing games or use cash, on the day of the game. Credit cards can be used, however, the way that Pecan Hollow's system works, can take up to 90 seconds to process the transaction on a credit card. You could stand in line for a longer period of time during the rush.
8. The golf course will be getting 70 new golf carts in November 2020.
