

PSMGA TOURNAMENT PROCEDURES 2021

State and Local Protocols for Social Distancing will be enforced. Maintain 6 feet distance, when possible, and wear a mask when required.

1. Previous Thursday “Gold Tee” tournaments have been canceled indefinitely. This decision was made by the Pecan Hollow management. The management decided that it would be more beneficiary, for the course, not to have any tournaments on Thursdays. Open play will still be available for those who want to play on that day.
2. For the Monday’s scheduled tournaments, the course will be set up to accommodate both high and low handicappers. The Monday tournaments will be played from the “Gold Tees”. Some of the holes could be modified, at times, to maintain the competitiveness and the enjoyment of the game. There will only be one tee box (GOLD) played. The total yardage will be estimated between 5200-5400 yards.
3. GOLF CARTS: Two players per cart will be utilized. At the time of registration, you will have the option to “Pick” your cart partner. The field will be limited to the first 130 players. Registration procedures will be addressed prior to the start date of the tournament.
4. Purchase of new “Punch Cards” will be available on 1 December 2020. The cost will be \$300 for 10 rounds of golf. This is still a \$5 discount off normal senior rates (\$35). The punch cards can only be used on Mondays through Thursdays (excluding holidays).
5. Day of the Tournament: The Pro Shop is recommending that players purchase a punch card or use cash. Credit cards can be used, however, the way that Pecan Hollow system works, it could take up to 90 seconds to process the credit card transaction. You could stand in line for long period of time during the rush periods.
6. The Optional (Closest-to-Pin and Hole-In-One) Game Table: The same procedures as before. However, **FACE MASK AND /OR COVERINGS WILL BE REQUIRED BY ALL PLAYERS and MAINTAIN 6 FEET DISTANCE**. The status of the HIO funds was stated in the previous Newsletter. Currently the Board decided to leave the “Thursday Gold Tee Funds” as it is, in case we start back the Thursday tournament. The current HIO fund available is \$7797.00. The payouts for the Closest-To-Pin will be added to that player’s account balance. There will no longer be Cash Payouts.
7. Scoring Table: In order to maintain Social Distancing, it is recommended that the players, once they finish their rounds, just drop off their scorecards at the scoring table. Please do not linger around the scoring table.
